3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

When parents bring their children for baptism, the first thing in the ceremony that the priest or deacon asks them is, "What name have you given to your child?" Parents select the names they bestow on their children for a host of reasons: family tradition, personal meaning, a connection to admired individuals, the beauty of how it sounds, or a name's particular meaning are but a few. Even if a child later on chooses to be known by some other name, most often it will be a variation of the original given by the parents. Elizabeth can become Betty or Liza; Robert turns into Bob; Jason shortens to Jase; and Caroline can be known as Carly.

Scripture scholars are divided on whether the person named at the beginning of Luke's Gospel is a particular individual, or whether he stands for all those who would hear the story of Jesus. His name, Theophilus, means one who loves God, so the name could be just as likely allegorical as actual. In any event, the story of Jesus that Luke organized and wrote is directed toward someone whose very name suggests a connection to the divine. The good news of Jesus is intended for one who loves God.

That does not mean to exclude every Tom, Dick, and Harry (or Barb, Jane, and Mary for that matter). No matter what our first name actually means, as a son or daughter of God in baptism, we are all "Theophilus," that is, lovers of God. The story of Jesus-the welcome he gives to the poor and the outcast, the Spirit that is poured out on him and on his followers, the journey to Jerusalem where the fulfillment of the Father's will is accomplished-is our story. And as we listen to the Gospel from Luke in the year ahead we can pray that we become ever more lovers of God, who calls us all by name.

3ER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

En el 2013 los Evangelios del domingo casi todos serán de Lucas. La primera parte del texto de hoy es el prefacio del Evangelio, en el cual se explica cómo y por qué Lucas escribió este Evangelio. El Evangelista procura proveer un resumen en orden basado en las tradiciones sobre el nacimiento de Jesús, sus enseñanzas y otras actividades de su ministerio público, su pasión, muerte y resurrección. Su meta fue la de confirmar y confiar las instrucciones a su lector, Teófilo. "Yo también, ilustre Teófilo, después de haberme informado minuciosamente de todo, desde sus principios, pensé escribirte por orden, para que veas la verdad de lo que se te ha enseñado".

En la segunda parte Lucas describe un prefacio acerca del ministerio público de Jesús. El pasaje describe a Jesús como el Profeta de Dios, ungido por el Espíritu Santo en su ministerio público, clave momento para la salvación de la historia. De acuerdo a la narración de Lucas la primera aparición pública de Jesús toma lugar en la sinagoga de Nazaret. Fijémonos que uno de los títulos que Lucas da a Jesús es el de profeta. En el Antiguo Testamento un profeta era enviado por Dios para proclamar anunciar la paz y la justicia. Como Profeta de Dios, Jesús anuncia las buenas noticias a los pobres, y dará libertad a los cautivos. Otro aspecto que Lucas nos hace
