5TH SUNDAY OF LENT

In the 2012 film *Smashed*, which won the US Dramatic Special Jury Prize for Independent Film Producing at the Sundance Film Festival, Mary Elizabeth Winstead plays Kate, a young wife who struggles to get sober. She and her husband (played by Aaron Paul) like having a good time. But when her partying spirals downward, Kate fears that her job as an elementary school teacher is at risk and she needs deal with her alcoholism. The film chronicles Kate's (and her husband's) attempts to achieve sobriety, even as she discovers that her past can deeply affect her future.

The woman in the Gospel is unexpectedly brought before Jesus today. She is exposed in front of everyone. Here she is, being confronted with shame, and sin, and all the condemnation that the indignant elders could heap upon her. Jesus points out to her accusers their own shortcomings, and in light of that, they all fade away. She is left before him alone, and he admonishes her to avoid sin in the future.

While alcoholism is understood to be a disease and not so much a moral failing, there is human suffering that can be fallout from such an affliction. That's why one of the Twelve Steps in Alcoholics Anonymous is to be willing to make amends to all persons that have been harmed. Making amends is also part of the sacrament of penance. When confessing our sins, there is the expectation that we will have to make some sort of restitution. That's what real penance is: an amendment, that is, a correction of one's life. We've spent part of Lent examining our lives and assessing where we have failed in living according to God's will. Like Kate in the movie, maybe we've had a sudden moment of insight. Or maybe we've just come to the realization of what we need to correct. Now is the time for us to confess, to do penance, and to be reconciled to God and neighbor.

5º DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

De cualquier forma que veamos las lecturas del tiempo de Cuaresma nos daremos cuenta de que tal como el cauce de un río que se dirige al mar, éstas nos llevan a ver a Jesús como punto de partida y de llegada. Por ejemplo, en el Evangelio de hoy vemos lo fácil que fue apuntar con el dedo a la mujer encontrada en adulterio. Pero vemos también que la maldad de los acusadores nos lleva a interiorizar acerca del mal que llevamos dentro, y a la vez ver la gran oportunidad de arrepentirnos. Ojalá que esto también nos ayude a dejar de apuntar los errores de los demás. Conforme al Evangelio, los acusadores se retiraron avergonzados y quizás hasta pensando, ¿cómo es que Jesús perdonó a la mujer sin juzgarla de acuerdo a la ley?

La ley de Dios es diferente a la ley humana. Nadie de nosotros tenemos la capacidad de comprenderla. Esta historia es única en el Evangelio de Juan: imaginemos a Jesús como un sabio y gentil maestro, que podía guiar a su audiencia hacia nuevos y profundos sentimientos respecto a su Padre Dios, ya fuera en lugares públicos o en el templo. Jesús dejaba sorprendida a su audiencia. Y a nosotros, ¿cómo nos ha dejado la palabra de Dios este domingo? ¿En que nos ha sorprendido? Jesús invita a los acusadores, y a la acusada en este caso, a realizar y profundizar en el gran amor de Dios y del cuidado que tiene hacia cada uno. Jesús es el recurso de la nueva vida. El gozo de recibir su palabra nos debe de llevar a dar fruto en nuestra vida.
