THE 11TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

A lot was made in the last election about the two parties' differing appeals to women voters. Since the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the US Constitution, women have had the right to vote in every election. No candidate can afford to ignore more than half the population. Often the press will cite certain issues as being of particular concern to women (things like health care, violence, workplace equality, food security) as opposed to topics that the media would label as of more concern to men (defense, terrorism, banking and finance law). While legislators may find themselves attuned at one time to one part of the population, and then the other, in the end, they must respond to all of their constituents and be concerned with the common good.

The Gospel this weekend gives us an insight into the band of believers who followed Jesus in his ministry. Luke paints a portrait of a mixed group of followers. There were the Twelve, that is the apostles, but there were also a number of women, some of whom were influential people. We know from the letters of St. Paul that in the early church men and women worked together to build up the kingdom of God by spreading the message of Christ.

In forgiving the sinful woman in the Gospel, Jesus outlines a path to be taken in achieving the common good, a path of forgiveness and healing. These are not easy virtues to exercise in the political world, which is often a cutthroat, winner-take-all type of endeavor. As Christians, it is our duty to influence our legislators on the issues that will promote the common good of all rather than the personal good of some. As Luke's writings in his Gospel and in Acts of the Apostles points out, Christianity is a religion of community. In both our private and our public lives we profess our faith in Christ and we care for our neighbor.

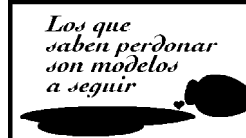

El Beato Juan Pablo II estremeció al mundo con la decisión que tomó al perdonar a su agresor después de haber sido baleado y estar al borde de la muerte. Muchos de nosotros nos preguntábamos, ¿por qué hace esto? En nuestra pobre imaginación deseábamos que el agresor se quedara por lo menos bastantes años en la cárcel. Sin embargo, no fue así. Un buen día el Papa decidió perdonarlo. La foto de su abrazo perdonándolo dio la vuelta al mundo. ¡Qué felicidad para el agresor el experimentar la compasión de Dios por medio de Su Santidad Juan Pablo II!

En el Evangelio de hoy el reconocimiento y la necesidad de perdón son el centro de la historia. La mujer entendía muy bien esta necesidad. Sin embargo Simón estaba ciego y hasta se atrevió a pensar y juzgar a Jesús: "Si este hombre fuera profeta, sabría qué clase de mujer es la que lo está tocando; sabría que es una pecadora". Simón señalaba el pecado, pero nunca se puso en los zapatos de la pecadora para entender su arrepentimiento. El ejemplo que Jesús da a Simón y los presentes es, sencillamente, el mostrar la profunda gratitud que la mujer mostraba hacia Dios al experimentar la reconciliación. Todos nosotros necesitamos el perdón y todos también debemos de aprender a perdonar. Las personas que saben perdonar son grandes modelos a seguir.
