29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

We have witnessed plenty of tragic events in our country's history. Very recent events, like the attacks on 9/11; Hurricane Katrina; the tornado through Joplin, Missouri; Super Storm Sandy; and plenty of other tragedies have affected wide swaths of the public. These events are so far-reaching, that almost everyone feels the impact. But these shattering events are no more devastating in their effects on the lives of individuals than the adversities that befall people each day: a diagnosis of cancer, a violent death in the family, a horrible accident, the loss of a job. Life's traumas can break into our own lives, or the lives of people we know, at any moment.

Jesus uses a curious example in the Gospel today. An unjust judge renders a helpful decision because of the incessant pestering of a widow. In the time of Jesus, widows were without recourse. They had no man to stand for them, so they were left to their own devices. The widow wears down the judge, who becomes fearful for his own well-being, unless he provides a just outcome.

We have seen it over and over again in our lives: when tragic events happen, people respond out of the goodness of their hearts. Whether it is a large-scale response as in the case of hurricanes or storms, or the compassionate outreach of a small group of neighbors and friends, in a time of need, it seems as though there is always someone who steps up to help. God is there too. We may not always be aware of God's presence, but he is with us in the darkest moments of life. Our prayer to God is not so much pestering an unjust judge (for God can never be unjust) as it is reminding ourselves that God is near to us. In the dark and difficult moments of our existence, God is there, and our prayer keeps us close to him.

El Señor insiste en que no debemos de desanimarnos al hacer nuestra oración. La persistencia en la oración nos guía hacia la justicia. La parábola de hoy da comienzo con la presentación de los dos personajes centrales: un juez que dos veces declara no temerle a Dios y no respetaba a la gente, y una viuda que venía a él una y otra vez con el mismo argumento de actuar con justicia hacia sus adversarios.

¡Todos debemos de orar! Por una reforma migratoria justa, para que termine la violencia, para tener trabajo, por los padres y madres de familia, por nuestras demás necesidades, para dar gracias: por todo esto y más debemos de orar. Jesús nos invita a ver la gran diferencia que existe entre el juez de la parábola y el juez que es nuestro Dios, siempre bondadoso y bueno. La viuda representa a cada uno de nosotros que clama por sus derechos para que el Reino de Dios se haga presente. Su pequeñez ante el juez se hizo grande por su fe. ¿De qué forma nuestra fe nos lleva a actuar para que la justicia llegue a todos? ¿Cómo uso el poder de mi voz y voto para luchar por la justicia?
