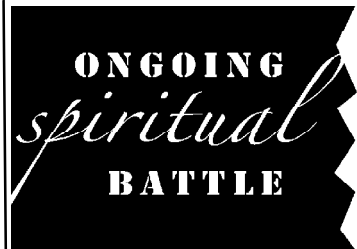

**1ST SUNDAY OF LENT**

“Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil.” Today’s Gospel brings us face-to-face with the reality of spiritual warfare. A battle is going on in the desert. The devil is out to win the allegiance of the Son of God. But Jesus fights back. Not with fists or knives, but with the word of God. For every temptation the devil proposes, Jesus arms himself with “the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God” (Eph 6:17). This strategy proves effective. Ultimately, “the devil left him,” and then Jesus was consoled by the presence of angels.

In our modern era, we face a new temptation: to deny the existence of spiritual beings. Angels appear to be little more than lawn ornaments or Christmas crafts, and too often the devil is reduced to an analogy for the vague presence of evil. Perhaps the greatest achievement of the father of lies, as Pope Francis has suggested, is to make us believe that he does not exist. But the word of God gives us a different idea: “Be sober and vigilant. Your opponent the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour” (1 Pt 5:8). This is no fairy tale. Satan wants to win our allegiance too.

During Lent, we have the opportunity to fortify ourselves for this serious, if silent, combat. Just as Jesus fasted and prayed for forty days before that diabolical encounter, we take these forty days of Lent to “conquer” the weak spots where we are susceptible to attack. We fast to strengthen our self-control, we give alms to strengthen our generosity, and we pray to strengthen our faith in God’s power and providence. A sincere effort now, in the “desert” of Lent, can lead us to victory as we engage in the ongoing spiritual battle for the allegiance of our souls.

**1ER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA**

Es importante que sepamos entender la temporada de Cuaresma. La Cuaresma da comienzo con el Miércoles de Ceniza y concluye con la celebración de la Cena del Señor el Jueves Santo. La temporada santa nos lleva a un retiro anual hacia una continua conversión al Evangelio. No es suficiente el tomar la ceniza en la frente; la Cuaresma es la conversión del corazón mediante la práctica de la oración, el ayuno y la corresponsabilidad. Este tiempo también nos ayuda a enderezar nuestra vida de cristianos. No desperdiciemos este período de purificación e iluminación. Más bien, caminemos junto con los catecúmenos hacia la vida nueva por medio de nuestro bautismo.

Durante cuarenta días Jesús estuvo en el desierto y ahí fue tentado. Cuando tuvo hambre, el demonio le pidió convertir las piedras en pan, pero su respuesta fue la de continuar con su ayuno espiritual. Cuando se le pidió que se tirara del Templo, la respuesta fue: “No tentarás al Señor, tu Dios”. Es decir, Jesús continuó con su vida sencilla predicando el Reino de Dios. Finalmente, su espíritu fue tentado a revelarse contra Dios adorando el mal. La repuesta fue la misma: la confianza total en Dios. Cuando el mal -en forma de tentación- se acerca a nosotros, ¿de qué forma respondemos? ¿Somos como Jesús, firmes en la confianza y la fe en nuestro Padre Dios? ¿O por el contrario nos dejamos vislumbrar con lo que nos rodea y caemos en las tentaciones que sufrimos todos los días entre el bien y el mal? La Cuaresma es pues el tiempo para encontrar la plenitud y dar acceso a la limpieza del corazón.
