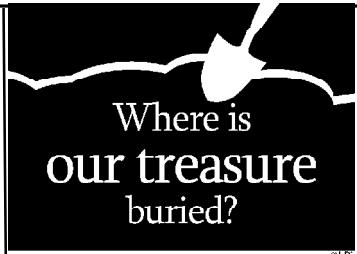

price"? How many of us really recognize the precious treasure we already possess? As baptized Christians, we have been welcomed into God's family. We are royalty in his kingdom! No matter what our status may be on earth, no matter what treasures we may or may not own right now, we are heirs of God's heavenly kingdom.

It is easy to take this for granted, however. On this side of eternity, it's even a temptation to forget that we have been adopted into God's family. Right now, for us, "the kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field." That is to say, the treasure isn't always so obvious. But that doesn't mean it isn't there. It just means that we have to dig a little bit to find it. We have to remove whatever layers of dirt or sand may be obscuring the priceless package and bring it back into the daylight.

So where is our treasure buried? What, if anything, is obscuring the full flourishing of our faith? Is it buried by the demands of work or school? Is our faith hidden beneath the weight of sickness or sorrow? Have we covered it over with false "treasures" that only give us fleeting joy? Or have we never even given our faith the chance to come into the sunlight at all?

Whatever it is for each one of us, we should resolve to recover the treasure that lies beneath our feet. By giving ourselves to Christ, encountering him regularly through prayer, Scripture study, and the sacraments, we too can experience the joy of that blessed merchant who, by selling all he had, truly became rich.

El Evangelio de este domingo está centrado en dos parábolas. Nos muestran lo que hacen las personas que han encontrado el tesoro del Reino de Dios. Es decir, lo que hacen las personas que han encontrado a Jesucristo y mantienen una relación e intimidad personal con él. Estos individuos no desean tener otra cosa, ni se entretienen en cosas y deseos superfluos. Se deshacen de lo que no le sirve y solo conservan lo bueno. Por lo tanto, estas parábolas nos invitan a reflexionar: ¿cómo podemos encontrar ese tesoro en la actualidad? La respuesta para nosotros puede ser el mismo día domingo, al dejar todo de lado para buscar el tesoro escondido en la Palabra de Dios y la Eucaristía. El valor del domingo es celebrar la resurrección del Señor y recordar que estamos llevando una vida nueva, llena de gracia, y amor. ¿Es esto el domingo para mí? ¿Cómo lo vivo? ¿Qué hago? ¿Con quién lo disfruto?

Nuestro ser busca el tesoro escondido. Y lo seguirá buscando hasta que se le tome sentido al Reino de Dios en esta vida. Sabemos que este tesoro no es fácil de buscar, ya que se encuentra enterrado en lo más profundo de nuestro corazón. Por esa razón el Rey Salomón en la primera lectura de hoy pide sabiduría para discernir entre lo bueno y lo malo. Él vivía situaciones parecidas a las nuestras, al escoger entre lo necesario y lo superfluo. No nos dejemos confundir: la publicidad nos ofrece muchos productos innecesarios. ¡Ojalá que este domingo pidamos sabiduría para pedir lo que verdaderamente necesitamos!
