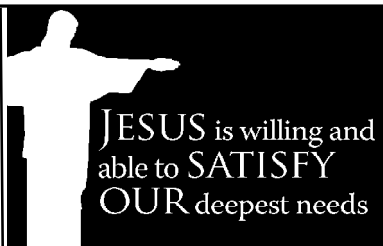

18H SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"He withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself." In the midst of his own sorrow at the murder of his cousin and friend, John the Baptist, Jesus had wanted to be alone. We can imagine how he might have been dealing with his sadness, perhaps shedding some tears and most likely praying to his Father in heaven. Yet his privacy was not respected at this difficult moment. Instead, a crowd of more than five thousand people found out where he was and "followed him on foot from their towns." Anyone else might have been annoyed in this situation. But Jesus was compassionate. Rather than wallowing in his own emotion, he thought of the men, women, and children who had made the journey to this remote location to be near him. "His heart was moved with pity for them, and he cured their sick."

Imagine the sick people who came to see Jesus. Imagine their hopes, their expectations, and the sacrifices they made to be in his presence. Jesus understood all of this. His emotions turned in their direction now as the sight of them touched his heart. And he cured them. And then, he fed them. Not only those who were sick, but all those present. First, the miracles of healing. Then, the miracle of multiplying the loaves and fish. What an experience it must have been to be among this crowd!

This Jesus of compassion and healing, this Jesus who provided for his people until they "were satisfied," this is our Jesus too. His sacred heart is also moved by seeing us, by recognizing our weaknesses, hopes, and desires. Jesus remains the same. He is willing and able to satisfy our deepest needs. The question is whether we, like the crowd that day, will make the journey to find him.

18º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



La liturgia de hoy nos brinda un gran cambio. Hemos dejado atrás el capítulo de las parábolas y entramos en un capítulo nuevo de Mateo, quien nos narra la actividad de Jesús. Esta actividad es llevada a cabo en un contexto de medios muy pobres. Se nos narra que Jesús solo quería un lugar solitario para orar. Sin embargo, la gente se congrega alrededor de Jesús y él se entrega a ellos en una actitud de gran calidad y compasión: "Cuando Jesús desembarcó, vio aquella muchedumbre, se compadeció de ella y curó a los enfermos". ¿Qué podemos aprender de esta acción de Jesús? La calidad pastoral no depende de las personas que nos busquen, ni quienes son las personas implicadas y ni si tienen dinero o son pobres. La calidad pastoral depende más bien de la forma cómo recibamos a estas personas y de que éstas puedan encontrarse con Jesucristo.

El Evangelio de hoy nos narra que los compañeros de Jesús no tenían la misma voluntad. Unos optaban por despedir a la gente, y que buscaran comida en otro lado. Sin embargo, Jesús les dice: "No hace falta que vayan. Denles ustedes de comer". Por lo tanto, debemos de buscar a Jesús siempre, acercándonos a él para que sacie todas nuestras necesidades. ¡Felicidades a las personas que domingo a domingo están en la iglesia para celebrar la Eucaristía, siguiendo a Jesús y buscándolo sin cesar! Felicidades a estas personas que saben que solo el Señor Jesús cura todas nuestras enfermedades: físicas, emocionales y espirituales. Hagamos caso a la invitación del Papa Francisco y luchemos para que termine el hambre en el mundo. ¡Todos podemos compartir de nuestra mesa! Recordemos que Dios es misericordia y amor y que nosotros, sus hijos e hijas, somos su reflejo.
