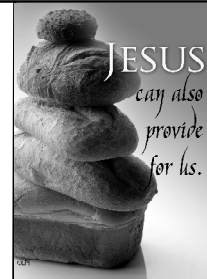

17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

“A large crowd followed him, because they saw the signs he was performing on the sick.” Jesus was attracting attention because of the miracles he had been working. Word spread, and people wanted to see it for themselves. In today’s Gospel, a huge crowd—five thousand men—gathered to see if Jesus was really a miracle worker. And he didn’t let them down. This time, instead of performing a miraculous healing for someone who was sick, Jesus performed a miracle that helped everyone who was there. He fed them all, out of the tiniest bit of food: five barley loaves and two fish. And with twelve baskets of leftovers to boot!

In case any of them had been in doubt before, this sign made it clear. Jesus was the Messiah. The people said, “This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world.” Each person in attendance had a personal experience of the power and providence of the Lord that day when they ate their fill. Jesus not only met their needs, but he went above and beyond this by multiplying the loaves and fishes in such abundance. It was as if he was saying, “I want you to have what you need and more. And I have the power to provide it for you.”

This miracle-working, food-producing, need-meeting Jesus is the same Jesus that we believe in. This is the same man that we call our savior. This is the Lord we pray to and the One to whom we entrust our lives. This ancient Gospel story is not irrelevant to our lives; it is also part of our story, here, today. Jesus can also provide for us. He has the power, and the desire, to give us all that we need and even more. He wants to feed us, too, with a satisfied and abundant life, a life of lasting fulfillment.

17º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

De Marcos, pasamos al capítulo 6 de Juan. Notemos que a diferencia de los Evangelios sinópticos, en Juan es Jesús quien reparte los panes, haciendo hincapié que todos son invitados que tiene todo en una mesa y Jesús es el único que da de comer. “Enseguida tomó Jesús los panes, y después de dar gracias a Dios, se los fue repartiendo a los que se habían sentado” (6, 11). Toda la narración tiene un sentido profético con referencia a la institución de la Eucaristía.

El mensaje de Jesús es importante, él también se preocupa de las cosas materiales que ocupa la persona. No se puede evangelizar si se tiene hambre. La justicia es llevar lo necesario y luego hacer la labor del ministerio. Esto nos lo han enseñado dos grandes profetas de nuestro tiempo. Monseñor Romero y la Madre Teresa de Calcuta. Ellos abogaron por un mundo más justo y más humano, donde la paz pueda reinar en el corazón de cada individuo. Ahora, el Papa Francisco también nos dice en su Exhortación Apostólica, “La Alegría del Evangelio”, lo siguiente: “El bien siempre tiende a comunicarse. Toda experiencia auténtica de verdad y de belleza busca por sí misma su expansión, y cualquier persona que viva una profunda liberación adquiere mayor sensibilidad ante las necesidades de los demás” (§9). Analizando este mensaje, ¿qué significa para ti comulgar el cuerpo y la sangre del Señor? ¿Estamos dispuestos a cooperar con tus cinco panes y dos pescados? Debemos de usar el sentido común para dar de comer a tantas personas que lo necesitan. ¡Así sea!
